

## **Laboratory Accreditation Status**

## ISO 17025 Accreditation

- Before the launch of the RMTC Drug Testing Initiatives Task Force at the end of 2008, 5 of 18 U.S. horse racing testing laboratories were ISO 17025 accredited. The ISO accredited labs at that time were:
