## ARCI-011-020

- F. Intra-articular injections
- (1) The use of intra-articular injections in flat and jump racing shall be governed by the following by the following conditions:
  - a. Treatment reporting is required pursuant to ARCI 011-010 (2)
  - b. A treated horse shall be established as ineligible to race for a period of 14 days following an intra-articular injection
    - i. For the purposes of counting the number of days a horse is ineligible to run, the day the horse was administered the intra-articular injection is the first day.
    - ii. The horse is eligible to race on the fifteenth day
- G. <u>Corticosteroids</u>
- (1) The detection of two or more corticosteroids in a flat or jump racing horse's post-race serum/plasma and/or urine sample constitutes a stacking violation (Penalty Class B)
